The state still has not responded to the ICP policy. The committee that is deciding the computer program will meet again. Elite supports the use of Gotsoccer. It can help with field allocation and integrating college coaches. The city could also use our system as a view only so they would know at any time what teams or leagues are using a field.

Mike Thompson: Treasurer:

Everything has been finalized with Esquire Group. The first checks have been cut through Quick books. Quality P&L statements will be available for budget meetings and AGMs. Mike will be setting up automatic bill pay with all monthly bills.

Need to make a rough draft of rules that we can have on web-site so that everyone knows that rules and have a place to access them.
